Mission of the Asian American Women's Coalition:

To promote the advancement of Asian American women through leadership and mutual support. The intent of the scholarship is to help a financially needy Asian American female student who has excelled in her studies or other fields of endeavor and to advance her career through an undergraduate education.

The award will be given in \$1,250 increments at the beginning of each scholastic year, for a total of four years in the amount of \$5,000. After the first payment is given to the winner, the next increments will be paid on the condition that the student maintains a 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

What are the requirements?

- At least a 3.0 cumulative grade point average on a 4.0 scale (official school transcript)
- Application form
- Demonstration of financial need (applicant and family's tax returns; FAFSA)
- Extracurricular activities and community service
- Two (2) recommendations (at least one from a teacher)
- Attendance at a high school located within the Delaware Valley

What is the Delaware Valley?

The Delaware Valley includes Philadelphia and the surrounding counties (Montgomery, Chester, Delaware, and Bucks) in Pennsylvania; Southern New Jersey (Camden and Atlantic County); and New Castle County, Delaware.

When will applicants be notified if selected for an interview?

ONLY finalists will be notified in April 2010 for an interview that will be scheduled with the Scholarship Selection Committee.

The winner must attend the Awards Ceremony Dinner to be held June 2010 in Philadelphia.
